Position Summary

Based on experience, Technicians are responsible for performing basic to advanced maintenance functions, procedures, activities, and responsibilities associated with working on gas compression packages and/or process equipment under general guidance. Has a strong mechanical aptitude, diagnostic, and troubleshooting repair skills. May assist other field positions.

Duties include servicing, minor and major repairs, overhauls, troubleshooting, installation, and start-ups of mainly gas fired and some electric driven compressor packages. Technicians acquire the proficiency in performing preventative maintenance, minor to advanced maintenance, overhauls, and equipment installations for a career progression plan.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Represents the company in a professional manner while providing outstanding customer service and support that aligns with UpLift's core values, handbook, customer commitment, and vision.
- Ensure routine maintenance plan in place to minimize down time on all assigned equipment.
- FST II or Sr Technician works independently or with minimal supervision to perform all tasks.
- Ability to operate all kinds of diagnostic and alignment tools, arrange for training and support.
- Independently diagnose/troubleshoot engine/compressor failures accurately and efficiently.
- Responsible for accurately completing engine tuning functions to adjust engine performance and emission on major OEM's CAT, Waukesha, Cummins, etc.
- Provides communication to the Sr Tech or Supervisor on personnel, repairs, and monitors job parts and supply inventories to minimize investment while maintaining an adequate level to ensure effective job performance.
- Complete accurate and timely rebuilds/overhauls of engines, compressors, and controls on gas compressor packages.

- Responsible for troubleshooting or identification of electrical systems, basic controls, and package control
 panels.
- Ability to independently assist with installation of package units including start-up, testing, inspections with little to no supervision.
- Maintains all units in a Safe and well-organized work environment.
- Works alone or with others to perform Call Outs, Preventative Maintenance, Major Maintenance, Overhauls, MOB/DMOB, repair recurring problems, etc.
